On January 21 in Humboldt Superior Court Kyle Clark also known as Kyle Winterheimer, pled guilty to felony violations of Health and Safety Code sections 11360, 11359 and 11350 for transporting Marijuana, possessing it for sale and possessing cocaine.

Judge W. Bruce Watson sentenced Mr. Clark to prison for the term of 4 years. The co-defendant in the case, Cameo Moore, pled guilty to transportation of Marijuana and is scheduled to be sentenced on February 18, 2009. She is facing a term in the local jail and felony probation.

On December 26, 2007 agents with the Humboldt County Drug Task Force were contacted by the Eureka Police Department after they were notified that packages were being mailed that contained over six pounds of Marijuana. Ms. Moore had personally delivered the packages for mailing. Members of the Humboldt County Drug Task Force then prepared and served a search warrant at the home of Kyle Clark and found another two pounds of marijuana bud, one gram of cocaine, \$3,070 in cash and packaging materials.

Mr Clark has been in custody on a warrant from Utah for possession with intent to distribute drugs. He has now waived extradition.

The case was prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Maggie Fleming. Mr Jeffrey Schwartz represented Mr. Clark and Mr. Ben Okin represented Ms. Moore.
