Davari Lamont Murry plead guilty today in Department 1 of Humboldt Superior Court, before the Honorable W. Bruce Watson, to committing first degree robbery with a sentence enhancement for another principal being armed with a firearm. Murry received an agreed upon prison sentence of 6 years in prison. The 6 year sentence represents four years for the robbery and an additional two years for the involvement of the firearm.

Mr. Murray, was accused with co-defendants, Willis and John Alcutt of entering into a residence in McKinleyville for the claimed purpose of purchasing marijuana from an individual who claimed to be cultivating marijuana for his own use under a physician's recommendation pursuant to the Compassionate Use act. While that individual was attempting to sell marijuana to Mr. Murray and his co-defendants they drew weapons and attempted to rob him of the marijuana. The resident was able to access a firearm in his house, and shot at Mr. Murray and co-defendant, Willis Alcutt.

Willis Alcutt was shot as he was attempting to flee the residence and subsequently was required to obtain medical care for his injury. Willis Alcutt plead guilty on March 9, 2009. A bench warrant in the amount of \$100,000 is out for the arrest of John Alcutt.
