## **APPLICATION GUIDELINES FY 2011-2012 SDF GRANTS**

1. The Humboldt County Indian Gaming Local Community Benefit Committee (Committee) will formally release grant applications on March 4, 2011. Eligible applicants may submit applications until April 4, 2011. Applications may be obtained by calling Humboldt County at (707) 476-2396.
2. Eligible applicants must submit four (4) copies of completed applications with authorized signature, to the County of Humboldt, 825 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Room 111, Eureka, California 95501, by 5:00 p.m., April 4, 2011. One copy will be kept on file and one copy will be sent to each of the Tribes that pay into the Special Distribution Fund.
3. Guidelines for applicants, supplemental information and agenda for Committee meetings are available upon request. Project applications will be evaluated based solely upon submitted materials.
4. On or about April 14, 2011, the Committee will review the applications, assess the eligibility of each applicant applying for grant funds; determine the appropriate amount for reimbursement of the costs incurred by the County to administer the grant program; and select projects for funding.
5. Upon approval by the Committee, the list of projects approved for funding will be immediately transmitted to the State Controller.
6. The State Controller will disburse funds directly to the local government jurisdictions whose grant applications were selected by the Committee.
7. Grant recipients must submit a report to the Committee for invoices/accounting and project completion/performance review by September, 2011.

## **APPLICATION PROVISIONS**

1. The Indian Gaming Special Distribution Fund Grant Program has been created for local government agencies impacted by tribal gaming. When describing the impacts associated with tribal casinos, it is important to note that this question does not pertain to impacts of Tribal uses not related to gaming.
2. The amount of SB 621 grant funding requested for the project through the application must be listed.
3. The signature at the bottom of the application should be that of the individual who has been authorized to discuss all aspects of the project.
4. The contact person listed should be the individual most knowledgeable about the project and authorized to discuss all aspects of the project.

5. The total costs of the project should include costs funded by other sources and the total funding requested through this application.

#### SPECIAL NOTES

1. Applicants must provide evidence and/or documentation to quantify the impacts of Indian Gaming as it relates to the project and the requested funding..
2. A grant may not be made for any purpose that would support or fund, either directly or indirectly, any effort related to opposition or challenge of Indian gaming in the State, and, to the extent any awarded grant funds are used for any prohibited purpose by any local government, upon notice given to the Committee by and Humboldt County Tribe with an operating casino, the grant shall terminate immediately and any funds unspent shall be made available for qualified grants.
3. A local government jurisdiction that is a recipient of a grant by the Committee shall provide notice to the public, either through a slogan, signage, or other mechanism, stating that the local government project has received funding from the Indian Gaming Special Distribution Fund.
4. Applicants are encouraged to submit grants requesting funds for infrastructure improvements and material purchases. Project applications requesting multi-year personnel related funds will not be considered.
