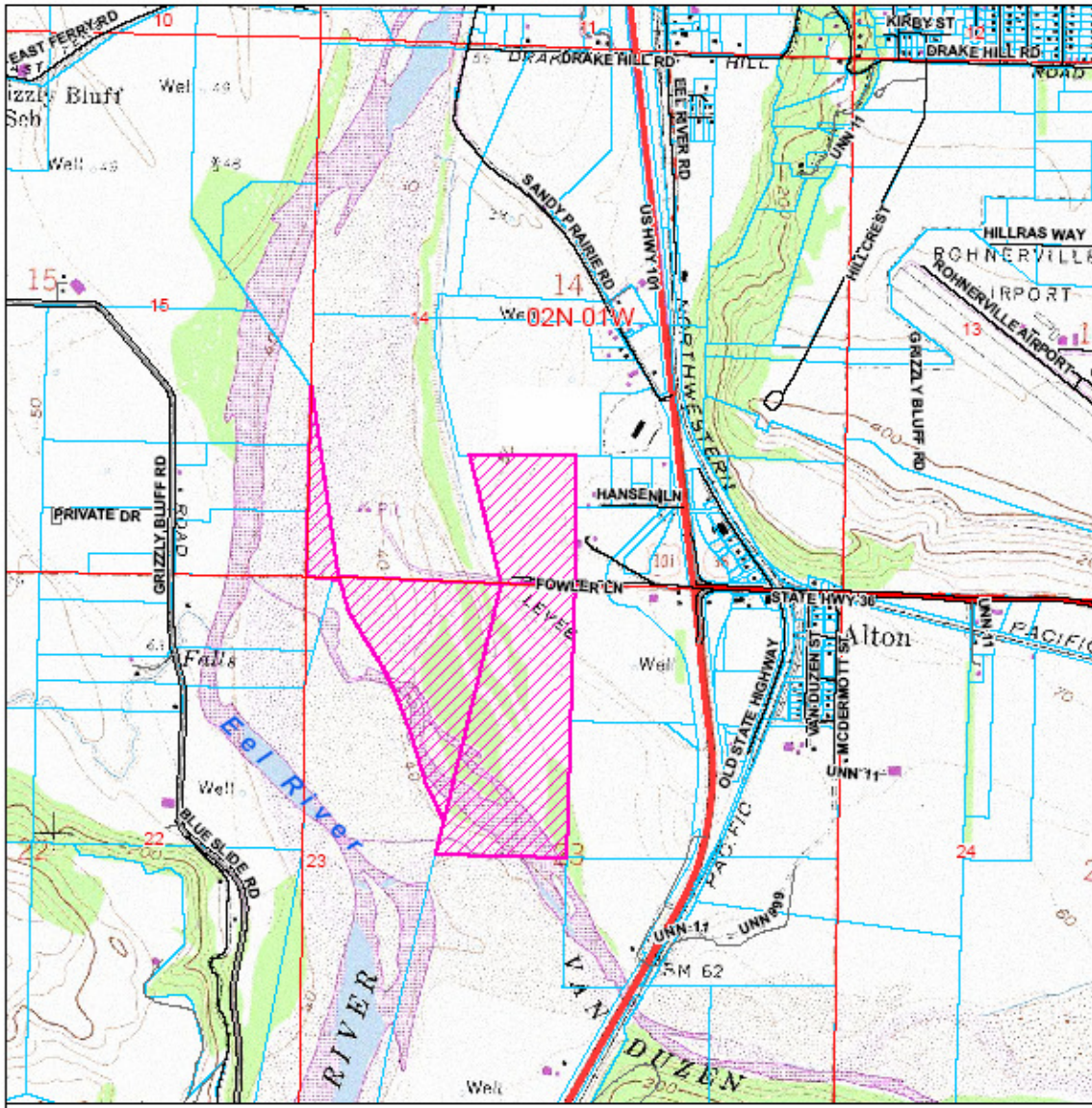

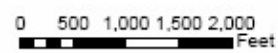
VICINITY MAP
