General Plan Update Workshops Draft Land Use Maps

Purpose of the Workshops

The workshops will provide the public with an opportunity to review the draft Land Use Maps for each community before they are reviewed by the Humboldt County Planning Commission in November. County staff and local service providers will also present information concerning infrastructure and land use development issues.

The maps will show proposed land use designations under three plan alternatives. The alternatives will focus on housing, infrastructure, and public services within the watersheds. The workshop will feature PowerPoint presentations that review the General Plan Update Process to date, watershed conditions, current infrastructure capacity, planned improvements, and a comparison of alternatives. The workshop will conclude with a public discussion of the draft land use maps and potential impacts from new development. Assistance from County staff will be available to those who want to discuss specific land use issues at the meeting.
