Courthouse Security Screening Information

The County of Humboldt and the Superior Court, under the supervision of the Humboldt County Sheriff's Office will begin mandatory courthouse security screening on Tuesday, October 14, 2008. Beginning on that date all persons entering the Humboldt County Courthouse, located at 825 Fifth Street, Eureka, California, will be required to enter and exit the courthouse by means of the designated entry screening areas. Those persons entering the courthouse will be required to submit their persons and property to security screening for weapons. Persons choosing not to be screened will be denied access to the courthouse.

It will be unlawful for any person to enter or exit, with the intent to circumvent courthouse entry screening or to leave the Humboldt County Courthouse by way of any access door, hallway, or entry way posted as "restricted" or "no access".

The following is a list of weapons or items that may not be brought into any court building in Humboldt County.

1. Any firearm, bullets, or ammunition possessed by anyone other than a peace officer, regardless of CCW
2. Any BB gun or pellet gun
3. Any replica or toy guns
4. Any Knife
5. Any chemical agents, including butane fuel
6. All stun guns, taser guns or deadly weapons
7. Handcuffs and/or handcuff keys – except those possessed by peace officers
8. Scissors
9. Screwdrivers with a shaft length of over two inches, pliers, wrenches, hammers, etc., in excess of six inches
10. Any razor or box cutting type knife
11. Metal comb-picks

12. Ice picks
13. Letter openers
14. Knitting needles
15. Any items which contain a concealed type weapon
16. Laser pointers
17. Any aerosol spray
18. Any flammable liquid
19. Any other pointed objects capable of inflicting a stab wound or objects with sharpened edges or surfaces capable of cutting
20. Any other type weapon prohibited by law
21. Skateboards/skates

Security personnel will not hold prohibited items while you are in the building. Anyone who enters the building with an item that is not allowed will be required to exit the building immediately and will need to properly secure the item before returning. Upon returning you will have to repeat the screening process and will not receive a pass to the front of the line, if there is one.
